#### H-R - RESIDENTIAL - CULTURAL - HISTORICAL ZONE

#### 18.35.010 Purpose.

The purpose of this zone is to provide for the protection of those residential sections of the town that are worth preserving because of historical, cultural and aesthetic or architectural interest. All remodeling or new structures must be compatible with established architectural styles and design elements as outlined in the town's "Guidelines and Criteria for Preservation and Development" manual and approved by the commission and board of trustees. [Ord. 94-06 § 1; prior code § 11-2-11.4.A]

#### 18.35.020 Uses permitted.

Uses permitted in the H-R zone are as follows:

Residential and related uses approved by the commission upon application and approval of a "development plan" (see MTC 18.50.030). [Ord. 94-06 § 1; prior code § 11-2-11.4.B]

#### 18.35.030 Exterior appearance.

An application for a permit which would authorize construction, modification, moving or destruction which would affect the exterior appearance of any structure, sign, or other improvement affecting use or function must first be approved by the commission. [Ord. 94-06 § 1; prior code § 11-2-11.4.C]

#### 18.35.040 New structures.

New structures may be built in this zone providing the exterior appearance of the structure is approved by the commission. [Ord. 94-06 § 1; prior code § 11-2-11.4.D]

#### 18.35.050 Height limitations.

Requires commission approval. No building or structure shall have a height greater than two stories or 30 feet, whichever is less. [Ord. 94-06 § 1; prior code § 11-2-11.4.E]

#### 18.35.060 Yards.

Requires approval by commission.

A. For all structures, side and rear yard must be at least seven feet unless structure meets UBC fire-resistive requirements.

B. In addition to subsection (A) of this section, a minimum setback of three feet in all yards is required for all newly constructed buildings. [Ord. 2001-04 § 2; Ord. 94-06 § 1; prior code § 11-2-11.4.F]

## 18.35.070 Development standards.

A. Lot Area. Each lot or parcel to be developed in the H-R zone shall have a minimum of 80 feet of frontage on a public street and a minimum of 8,000 square feet of area.

B. Population Density. When lots or parcels in the H-R zone are to be developed to multifamily dwellings, each lot or parcel shall have sufficient area to provide 4,000 square feet of area for each family unit to be erected.

C. Side and Rear Yard Setback. If found to be existing within the development zone pursuant to the YGUADO plan, structures (buildings) may be built up to the property line if constructed of materials that meet current building code fire-resistive requirements such as adobe or equivalent. Structures (buildings) using materials that do not meet current building code fire-resistive requirements must be set back at least seven feet from the side property line.

 Structures (buildings) constructed to the property line, "zero-lot-line," shall require a "right-of-entry" agreement signed by all property owners of all applicable properties for construction and maintenance that is recorded in Dona Ana County records and filed with the town clerk; and 2. This document must be acquired prior to planning, zoning, and historical appropriateness

commission approval; and

- 3. This document shall be permanent and remain with all properties regardless of ownership; and
- 4. In the event that a mutual agreement cannot be acquired, the applicant may:
  - a. Meet the required setback of seven feet, or
  - b. Apply for a variance through Chapter 18.85 MTC to the board of adjustment.

E. Utilities. All installations of utility lines shall be underground, wherever technically feasible. [Ord. 2006-03 § 1; Ord. 2004-7 § 6; Ord. 2001-04 § 2; Ord. 94-06 § 1; Ord. 92-07 § 1; prior code § 11-2-11.4.G]

# <u>PZHAC ACTION FORM</u> ZONING PERMIT 060869 [PZHAC REVIEW – 5/20/2019] STAFF ANALYSIS

# (Decision to be based on information presented during the Work Session – Item 3)

## Item:

**Case 060896** – 1680 Calle de Alvarez, submitted by Chris Schaefer; a request for a zoning permit to construct a freestanding directory sign on a commercial property at this address. Zoned: General Commercial (C)

This request received a recommendation of approval from the PZHAC on June 20, 2019 and was subsequently submitted to the BOT for approval at their June 28 regular meeting. Due to the fact that the proposed sign would be an off-premises directory sign, the request was tabled by the BOT in order for the applicant to obtain a variance from the Board of Adjustment (BOA) in order to allow the sign as an off-premises directory sign. A request for a variance from the BOA was granted for the sign on July 2, but this decision was appealed to the BOT on August 12 by Susan Krueger on the grounds that the BOA did not have the authority to allow a sign that was prohibited by the Code. The BOT denied the appeal and upheld the decision of the BOA. The original case is now being presented to the BOT by the applicant based on the fact that the applicant has received a variance from the BOA to allow the sign, as requested by the BOT on June 28, 2019.

## **Staff Analysis:**

The proposed request was discussed in the PZHAC Work Session held prior to this meeting. (Please refer to the information provided in the write-up for this item in the Work Session.)

If it is determined that the proposed sign will be acceptable for the zoning of the property, or if an alternate solution is arrived at, then the request can proceed on the assumption that all requirements of the Code will be satisfied. The PZHAC should continue on to approve the request based on the Findings stated below.

If, on the other hand, it is determined that the proposed sign will not be acceptable to the zoning of the property, and no other solution can be reached, then the PZHAC should either postpone the request further until the applicant can return with a proposal that meets the standards set forth by the PZHAC; or the PZHAC should deny the request based on the request not meeting any or all of the Findings as listed.

# **Consistency with the Code:**

The PZHAC will need to determine that the proposed sign will be consistent with the zoning requirements for this property. Additionally, the PZHAC will also need to determine that the request, as submitted, is consistent with the all other sections of the **Building and Zoning Codes** that may be applied to this project.

# Findings:

- The PZHAC has jurisdiction to review and approve this request.
- The proposed work consists of constructing a directory sign at 1680 Calle de Alvarez.
- The PZHAC has determined that the proposed work meets all applicable Code requirements.

# **PZHAC ACTION:**

The PZHAC determined that the proposed sign was definitely needed for the Mercado area, and voted 3 - 0 to recommend APPROVAL of this request to the BOT even though the sign will not be located on the same property as the businesses.

# PZHAC WORK SESSION MAY 20, 2019 ITEM 3

Submitted by Chris Schaefer for Paul Miller (property owner); a request to discuss plans to construct a freestanding directory sign on a commercial property at 1680 Calle de Alvarez. (Case 060896) Zoned: General Commercial (C)

## **DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:**

The applicant occupies part of a commercial building located in the commercial area behind the subject property. Currently, there is no indication or signs along Avenida de Mesilla that this commercial area exists or that there are commercial operations in the area. (This area is considered the "Mercado", or commercial, area of Mesilla.) According to the applicant, very few people who visit Mesilla are even aware that this area exists, so he would like to install what would be, in essence, a directional sign that will be located on the property that is at the entrance to the area and will list the businesses in the Mercado area. The following are the portions of the Sign Code that address Directory and Development Identification Signs: (The Sign Code is attached in its entirety at the end of this presentation.)

## 18.65.165 Directory signs.

A. A directory sign may be permitted for a building or development where there is more than one business or tenant. A directory sign may be a wall sign, projecting sign, or freestanding sign, provided the sign complies with all requirements for the type of sign.

B. A directory sign shall be limited to 15 square feet in area for signs located in the Historical Commercial (H-C zone) zone and 25 square feet in area for signs located in the Commercial (C) zone.

C. All directory signs shall be located on the premises where the businesses are located.

D. A directory sign may list all businesses or only the building or development name.

E. Each business may have one individual sign in addition to the identification on the directory sign, in accordance with the sign regulations and all other laws and ordinances. [Ord. 2008-04 § 10]

# 18.65.170 Development identification signs.

A development identification sign may be permitted at the entrance/exit to a commercial development to identify the development name and logo only.

A. The structure of a development identification sign shall be no larger than 48 square feet in size, and have a height no higher than four feet.

B. The actual sign portion of the development identification sign shall not exceed 25 square feet for the Commercial (C) zone, or 15 square feet for the Historic Commercial (H-C) zone. Area of the actual sign shall be determined by measuring the extent of the painted sign or graphic horizontally and vertically and calculating the area. [Ord. 2003-05 § 5; prior code § 11-3-17]

The PZHAC will need to decide if the proposed sign can be allowed as a directory sign, or if it falls under any other category.

The applicant will be present to provide further information regarding this request, and to answer any questions that might arise.

# **Description of Work Done:**

The purpose of this request is to allow the applicant to repair and restore an existing structure at this address. Although zoned Historical Commercial, the structure was previously used as a dwelling until the applicant obtained it. The applicant proposes to use the structure to house a commercial consulting and contracting practice. The applicant applied for and received a permit in January of 2017 (Permit 060472) to renovate the structure. # **Chapter 18.33 – Historic Preservation**

# **18.33.040** Declaration of purpose and statement of public policy.

A. The board of trustees declares that the historical heritage of Mesilla and its historic buildings and its historic districts are among its most valued and important assets. The board finds that some buildings having historical, architectural, aesthetic and cultural value have been neglected, altered or destroyed notwithstanding the feasibility of preserving and continuing the use of such buildings and without adequate consideration of the irreplaceable loss to the public and the town. The board finds that the historic character of Mesilla is of vital importance in maintaining the economy of the town and that its historic landmarks and the buildings in its historic district can be preserved, rehabilitated and used. The board finds that this chapter benefits all the residents of Mesilla and all the owners of property.

B. The board of trustees declares as a matter of public policy that the preservation, protection and use of historic landmarks and buildings in the historic districts are a public necessity because they have a special character or a special historic, architectural, aesthetic or cultural value and thus serve as visible reminders of the history and heritage of this town, state and nation. The board declares as a matter of public policy that this chapter is required in the interest of the health, safety, welfare and economic well-being of the public. The board declares as a matter of public policy that the identification and designation of historic landmarks and historic districts and the approval or disapproval of exterior changes to designated property or their demolition or relocation or new construction on the site are stated to be a public purpose. [Ord. 2011-03]



The Town has previously approved permit #060472 which coveres general adobe repair, drainage and window/door repair for our property on 2214 Calle de Guadalupe. Attached is a new permit for the east and west door entryways, west awnings/porch and plaster color.

This new permit includes the east entryway which has some additional information not previously submitted. The color (white) of the doorway remains the same, the trim will be repaired and/or replaced. A new door appropriate for the time period and had been approved by the State Historic Preservation Office, see attached. New sidelights for the entryway will be built and installed matching the door.

The new permit also includes the west entry plan. The existing door was too narrow for ADA access so the plan calls for a wider doorway. The windows that are currently on either side will be re located to the south side of the door, see attached.


The exterior walls will be painted the color of the west side of the house.



### **Project update:**

Bowman Road Re-construction – Project close-out underway.

**LGRF** - Design is underway for the re-construction of Calle de Principal from Calle del Norte to Calle de Medanos.

**Parian Capital Outlay** - Design is underway for the re-construction of Calle de Parian at the intersection of Calle de Oeste.

La Llorona Extension multi-use path – Engineering fee negotiations are underway. Project is anticipated to be out to bid late January or early February.

**McDowell wastewater system Phase II** – Engineering services are being reviewed by NMED. Project is anticipated to be underway early January.

**Calle del Norte Trail Phase II** - The Town of Mesilla received information from NMDOT that the grant match waiver has been approved for the grant from the state special project fund (LGTPF) for the extension of the Mesilla trail system.
