Zoned: Historic Commercial (HC).
24 25 26 27	Commissioners Lucero and Salas stated that the reason the P&Z denied the case was that it would damage the adobe of a historically significant structure and that the proposed awning does not fit in with the development zone 18.33.
28 29 30	Mr. Ritter stated that these types of awnings have been in Mesilla for years. There are historical photographs of Mesilla Plaza shops utilizing these types of awnings.
31 32 33	Mr. Sam Caldera of SJC, Mr. Ritter's installer for the awning, demonstrated to the Trustees and the two present Commissioners that the awning is held into the wall by two bolts with a metal bracket that does not impact the integrity of the adobe. The only installation into the adobe is the two screws.
35 36 37	Commissioner Salas questioned as to how the bolts would hold in adobe because until they drill into the wall, they will not know if they will hold.
38 39	The Trustees asked additional questions regarding the installation process for the awning and the color and the placement of the proposed awning.
