- Garages, storage sheds are included in the five structures
- 45,000 sq. ft. would be required to build five multi-family units

Commissioner Salas:

- Dwellings are live able, structures are not live able
- Maximum two dwellings

Mayor Barraza:

- Prior to 1972 needs to be added
- "Will be decided" on a case-to-case basis; omitted "will be allowed"

Commissioner Nevarez stated he does not want to proceed as he thought the changes brought forth at the worksession would have been made. He would like the recording to be made available.
