The applicant proposes to erect a stone wall to match his current design. I've attached what was submitted with his last application. He will use 2 ft metal sections between the 5 ft pillars with two gates. The gates will be 71" at their peak.

COMMENTS

MFD, along with the rest of Dona Ana County, have experienced a rise in COVID related calls for service. As always we do our best to protect responders during these calls and continue to be vigilent concerning our members health and being fit to report for duty.

Two of our members will finish up their Emergency Medical Technicial classes next month along with one member each completing Emergecny Medical Responder and EMT-Intermediate classes.

The department received \$25,000 from the Fire Protection Grant Fund for stipends for firefighters. Staff is updating our current procedure for stipends in anticipation of using these funds to encourage retention of our volunteers.

University Waterline Improvements – Potholing of existing utilities is complete. Review and negotiations for engineering is underway.
